## **PURPOSE**

As the final formal event for the project, this gathering has been designed to serve the following purposes:

- 1) To disseminate the learnings from the project (new and revised approaches to teaching and learning at each institution in the pilot.
- 2) To communicate the interventions recommended for how to bring about reform within the University of Technology sector (packaged as policy briefs) to the broader Higher Education community, through the DHET, DSI, SAQA and CHE.
- 3) To identify and discuss ways to create synergies between the HERESA project and other initiatives/entities that align with HERESA mission.
- 4) To develop a framework for sustaining and increasing the footprint of HERESA in the future (i.e. beyond the current grant lifespan and geographical area) based on the learnings gathered during this piloting phase.

## **TARGETED AUDIENCE & SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES**

**Day 1**: On this day we will target primarily higher education policy and leadership audience in South Africa and in neighbouring SADC countries (3 countries Namibia, Botswana, Mauritius), but online and hybrid participation will be offered for all interested parties beyond; this includes organisations and consortiums involved in supporting universities achieve their learning and teaching objectives, such as SARUA and USAF. This day will be used disseminate the learnings from the HERESA project to the target audience and gather opinions on the significance and implications of these findings for the sector and HERESA's future, and well as the immediate policy implications.

Day 2: On this day the event will open to a wider audience of practitioners and project coordinators in Africa, Europe and further afield. It will be a means to cross-promote and share results, impacts, and products, assess the added value of the Erasmus+ Capacity Building action in Africa and also plan and brainstorm new project ideas.
